This flyer has been designed to provide Shelter volunteers data & images which may help to identify a Papillon. It is critical to a Papillon's well-being that it be promptly transitioned to a qualified caregiver home for proper assessment & care.

PCA Rescue Trust accepts Papillons regardless of age, temperament or health status.

All Papillon's in our program are placed into approved caregiver homes, fully vetted, and spayed/neutered prior to owner xfer. Applicants are well screened, including reference & home checks; prior to gaining foster or owner xfer approval. We carefully track the care each Papillon receives from the point of intake to, and even after, owner transfer (xfer).



Purebred Papillon's May Typically Be ...

- 8 - 11 inches in height, from shoulder down
- Weigh from 3 - 12 pounds
- Parti-color - white with patches of any other color
- Erect or Drop Ear , (Papillon or Phalene)
- Possibly large butterfly ears
- With medium length , single, silky textured coat
- Plume-tail which curls over its back
- Happy-go-lucky in temperament, everyone is its pal



There Are Always Exceptions ...

- May be above, or below, weight & height limits
- One ear may be erect, the other drop , or slightly tipped
- Differently textured coats are not uncommon
- May have an all white , or an all black , colored coat
- It may, or may not, have ear or tail fringe
- A frightened Papillon may carry its tail set low
- Acting withdrawn, even fearful, in a shelter is normal
